

SJCA Meeting Minutes
October 2, 2017

The meeting opened in prayer at 7:07 p.m.

- The KidStuff coupon book sale continues to be a success. As of the meeting time, the PTF profited \$1475 from the sale. Monies are still coming in and out of region books will be ordered on 10/3/2017. **Thank you** to all who worked diligently to sell the books. Each teacher will receive a complimentary book.
- The treasury currently has **\$7355.16**.
- The Yankee Candle sale began on 10/2 and will last until 10/16! Remember, we will receive 40% of all sales. While selling, please let supporters know that they will incur tax and shipping charges on all online sales. Ordering directly from the catalog and paying by cash/check/money order will eliminate tax and shipping charges. The classroom that receives the highest dollar amount of sales will receive a pajama day for the students. Mrs. Orme asked if the student/s who sell the most candles will receive individual prizes. The PTF will review 2016 minutes to review actions of last year. *Upon reviewing the 11/6/2016 minutes, the PTF simply announced the three top sellers in 2016. An additional incentive was not given.*
- Regarding future dine-out fundraisers: **Wendy's** (Sicklerville) will give 10% of the **total** sales during the fundraising period—which is typically 3 hours. It is not necessary to mention that you are dining with SJCA in order to receive sale credit at Wendy's. **Chipotle** will give 50% and **PDQ** (10%) of the total sales of all persons who *state that they are dining* with SJCA during the fundraising period. **Panera Bread** will give 20% of all persons who dine and present a flyer or phone image showing that they are with SJCA. Dine outs will be planned for the spring. Mrs. Hester will reach out to the proprietor of Mr. Bill's Ice Cream on Route 73 to learn of their fundraising activities.
